



**RANSOM MEANING:** A ransom is a price paid to liberate someone from bondage or captivity. A ransom is the price to actually set someone free from the threat of death.

### ***Additional Scriptures From Today's Message***

**Isaiah 53:5** - “He was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his wounds, we are healed”

**Romans 3:23-24** - “All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus”

**John 10:17-18** - The reason my Father loves me is that I lay down my life—only to take it up again. No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord. I have authority to lay it down and authority to take it up again. This command I received from my Father.”

**Exodus 21:28-30** - The ransom paid for the death from someone's animal

**Psalms 49:7-8** - No one can redeem the life of another or give to God a ransom for them— the ransom for a life is costly, no payment is ever enough

**John 3:16-18** - For God so loved the world, that he gave his one and only Son that whoever believes in him shall not perish, but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because they have not believed in the name of God's one and only Son
